Attaching the Hand Pump and Strap Non-Carbonated Backpack

- 1) Once you have connected both the Hand Pump and the Dispensing Hose & Gun to the 3-gallon/11.4-liter keg, put the keg inside the backpack.
- 2) Put the backpack on. For now, the Hand Pump will be hanging freely. Do not buckle the hip belt yet, just put on the backpack.
- 3) Take the Hand Pump in your hand. You will notice it has a strap, which is used for attaching the Hand Pump to the backpack. This strap is to go around the hip belt of the backpack. There are 2 pieces of velcro, which are used to go around the pump itself and attach the pump to the backpack.
- 4) Now buckle up the hip belt. You will have the dispensing hose and gun in one hand and now that you have the Hand Pump attached, you use your other hand to pump the Hand Pump when necessary to pressurize the keg.

OTHER NOTES

- The dispensing gun you have is brand new. Squeeze the trigger many times until it works smoothly. Some adjusting will be required. We test every hand pump and dispensing gun prior to shipment.
- You will notice that when you are dispensing, there will be a little beverage left in the hose after each time you use it. It appears that the gun is dripping. It isn't. You just have to get used to how the gun dispenses.
